MISSION STATEMENT

The Field Studies Program is a one week activity in the spring semester designed to enrich the curriculum by providing learning experiences in an environment beyond the classroom, exposing students to new mental, physical, and creative challenges, improving student morale and building social and spiritual relationships.

Bridgemont graduation requirements include the successful completion of field studies for every year in attendance. Each field study is designed with the Graduate Student Profile in mind and is evaluated on a letter grade basis, including a citizenship mark. The credit becomes part of each student's permanent transcript.

We are pleased to announce the 2012 Field Studies program for Bridgemont. A selection is offered to meet a range of student interests. Please take a few moments to read this.

Requirements: Students need to sign up for a field study program that will take place April 30 – May 4 2012. Field Studies fees are due February 15th, 2012. Sign up for the program by indicating 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th choices. A lottery will be conducted during lunch on Monday February 6, 2012. All forms turned in before the end of break will be part of the first draft. Forms turned in after February 6 will be assigned on a first come basis on the trips that have openings. If a student fails to sign up for a specific program, the student will be automatically enrolled in one of the programs listed.

Students are not allowed to change programs, so please choose wisely.

If you have questions on the Field Studies Program, please ask Mr. Anderson or individual trip leaders. The individual trip leaders will distribute specific itineraries and other detailed information at a later date. A mandatory student parent meeting is scheduled in the spring. Please avoid scheduling lessons, medical appointments and the like during this week, as scheduled events cannot be made up. Participation in all events is required for success on any field study. Failure can only be made up by the successful completion of a course with Fresno Pacific University independent study course program. It is the responsibility of the student to make arrangements to do this before graduation. The course must be related to field studies and be approved by Bridgemont.

Lottery Rules

- Students will be assigned to a field study after a lottery held at lunch on Monday Feb 6th, 2012.
- To be entered in the lottery each student must turn in a properly completed Field Studies Sign Up form to Mr. Anderson by 10 AM on February 6, 2012.
- Sign up forms turned in after 10AM on 2/6/2012 will not be eligible for the lottery and will be assigned trips on the order which the forms are received, after the lottery is completed.
- At lunch on 2/6/2012 the Field Studies Lottery will be performed. The Field Studies Sign Up Forms turned in on time will be drawn one at a time.
- Trips will be filled in the order the forms are drawn out of the box.
- Each senior will receive two entries in the lottery.
- Juniors, sophomores, and freshmen will have one entry each.
- Results of the lottery drawing are not final until all Field Studies Sign Up Forms are turned in and Mr. Anderson declares Field Studies Rosters official.
