Dear Parents,

A Bridgemont education is one of the most important and valuable investments you will ever make, and it will yield lifetime benefits. Bridgemont graduates have been accepted to some of the finest colleges and universities such as Biola, UC Schools, Morehouse, Loyola, Valparaiso, San Francisco State, San Diego State, George Fox etc. They are proof that the value gained from a Bridgemont education is well worth the investment.

Bridgemont works with several scholarship providers to help students pay for tuition. These providers (Dahl Trust, Guardsman, Basic Fund, IHAD etc.) are outside of Bridgemont and each have their own set of "ground rules" for applying and maintaining funding. The Bridgemont Scholarship Fund provides scholarships to students with demonstrated need, within the limits of the school's resources. Bridgemont actively seeks funding from foundations, churches corporations and individuals. These private donations along with various fundraising efforts make up the Bridgemont Scholarship Fund.

We take great pride in providing qualified students with scholarships that make a Bridgemont education possible. The scholarship committee will pay special attention to each family's specific financial needs. We encourage families to apply and to give us the opportunity to "share the value" with you.

With this goal in mind, Bridgemont holds to the following philosophy:

- We will partner with the student and his or her family to arrange financing for the student's education using the family's resources, extended family resources, church resources and Bridgemont's resources.
- Demonstrated need will be measured by a consistent and equitable need-analysis system. To be fair to all students seeking scholarships, need must be based objectively on a family's financial resources, not their willingness to pay.
- Special circumstances will be considered on a case-by-case basis, and we use our professional judgment to determine when adjustments should be made.
- Parents will register with eScrip and participate in school fundraising events.
- Students must maintain a 2.0 GPA.
