Dear Parents,

Please mark your calendar for Friday, February 3rd for our 9th annual Snow Day. Like "City Escape", our entire school will be getting out of town, with the big difference being that we will be going to the snow, specifically *Soda Springs Winter Resort*, in the Sierras.

Transportation will be via chartered bus. The charge for the event includes the cost of the bus and a tubing lift ticket at Soda Springs. Lunch is not included, so please have your student pack a lunch or bring money. There is a spacious, warm lodge where hot lunches, snacks and beverages can be purchased. Their prices are reasonable, relative to other ski resorts.

Please be sure that your student dresses appropriately. It's not necessary to go out and buy snow pants; jeans are fine, but bring a change of clothes. Bring warm outer wear, waterproof gloves and a knit cap. To prevent wetness, you might consider purchasing a can of Scotchguard from the store and spraying pants and shoes a few days before the trip.

Leave: 6:00a.m. SHARP! from Bridgemont - **BE AT SCHOOL BY 5:30 a.m.**

Return: 6:30 p.m. to 7:00p.m. to Bridgemont (approx.)

Cost: \$35.00

Where: Soda Springs (170 miles from San Francisco off of Highway 80/ approx 3 hours)

There is also the option of skiing or snowboarding. Once again Soda Springs has put together an extremely discounted package for Bridgemont. If your student would like to ski or snowboard, the additional cost is only \$40.00. This includes lift ticket, rental equipment and a 90 minute lesson. This is a great deal! If your student already has skis or snowboard equipment, Soda Springs is offering us a \$20.00 lift ticket.

**BOREAL MOUNTAIN RESORT/SODA SPRINGS MOUNTAIN RESORT
Winter Sports Activities Release of Liability and Indemnity Agreement**

READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING – THIS LIMITS BOREAL/SODA SPRING’S LIABILITY

I, _____, or my child (collectively referred to as “I”, “my”, or “me”) have voluntarily applied to participate in winter sports activities and other recreational activities at Boreal Mountain Resort and/or Soda Springs Mountain Resort, including but not limited to, skiing, snowboarding, snowtubing, sledding, all other winter sports or related activities, and all activities at Boreal Playland, Soda Springs Planet Kids, and Mini-Snowmobiles (collectively referred to as “the sport”). I understand that my participation in the sport poses risks of INJURY and DEATH. The risks include, but are not limited to, loss of control, collisions with other skiers, snowboarders, or tubers, collisions with natural and man-made objects, including trees, rocks, fences, lift towers, snow making equipment, and over-snow vehicles. The risks also include variations in terrain and snow conditions, surface and subsurface snow conditions, bare spots, bumps, moguls, ice, stumps, forest growth and debris, erosion control devices, rocks, cliffs, steep terrain, avalanches, and traveling in the mountains and beyond the ski area boundary. Other risks include those associated with the use of the facilities, including mountain transportation, lifts, terrain parks (jumps, rails, boxes, half pipes, and other park features), slope style, skier/boarder-cross, performing maneuvers (inverted or otherwise), walking in lodges and parking lots, and participating in lessons, races, tubing, sledding, and special events (collectively, “use of the facilities”). Despite these risks and all other risks, and **TO THE FULLEST EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW, I AGREE TO EXPRESSLY ASSUME ALL RISKS OF INJURY OR DEATH** that might be associated with or arise out of my participation in the sport or use of the facilities.

I understand that if I enter a terrain park, I must inspect the elements and terrain before I ski or ride over them to evaluate the risks and degree of difficulty before participating. I understand that throughout the day snow conditions and terrain features will change. I am solely responsible for knowing and understanding my ability to encounter all terrain features.

In consideration for being permitted to participate in the sport and to use the facilities, **I AGREE TO RELEASE FROM ANY LEGAL LIABILITY AND AGREE NEVER TO SUE** Boreal Ridge Corporation, Soda Springs, Powdr Corporation, Auburn Ski Club, or any of their parent companies, subsidiaries, owners, employees, agents, landowners, or The United States of America Department of Agriculture, Forest Service (collectively, “Boreal”) for injury or death resulting from my participation in the sport or use of the facilities, regardless of the cause, including the alleged **NEGLIGENCE** of Boreal. I further **AGREE TO DEFEND, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS** Boreal for any claims, lawsuits, damages, attorney fees, costs or judgments arising out of my participation or my child’s participation in the sport or use of the facilities.

I UNDERSTAND THIS IS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY THAT IS VALID FOREVER, and will apply whenever I participate in the sport or use the facilities at Boreal. I understand that this **RELEASE OF LIABILITY** will prevent me, my child, or my heirs from filing suit or making any claim for damages in the event of injury or death from my participation in the sport or use of the facilities. Additionally, in the event I file or my child or any legal representative files a claim or a lawsuit arising out of my participation in the sport or the use of the facilities at Boreal, **I AGREE TO DEFEND, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS** Boreal for any damages, attorney’s fees, or costs arising out of such a claim or a lawsuit. With a full understanding of this agreement, I nevertheless enter into this agreement freely and voluntarily and agree that it is binding upon me, my child, my heirs, assigns and legal representatives.

I hereby authorize the use and reproduction of my image and/or likeness by Boreal and its authorized representatives, without compensation or restriction. Photographers executing this agreement understand that images they take at Boreal may be used by Boreal, at any time, regardless of date used.

I understand and agree that this agreement is severable and that if any clause is found to be invalid, the balance of the contract will remain in effect and will be valid and enforceable. I agree that any action will be brought in the County of Nevada, State of California, or alternatively, in a court of competent jurisdiction in the State of California. Any disputes will be subject to and determined under the laws of the State of California.
